Licence Conditions and Codes of Practice – January 2009
ACCESS TO GAMBLING BY CHILDREN AND YOUNG PERSONS

It is illegal for any person who is under 18 years of age to play gaming machines of category A, B or C.

Statement:

The Company recognises its responsibility and obligation to comply with the Licensing Objectives of the Gambling Act 2005 and the Licence Conditions and Codes of Practice. Social responsibility awareness is an important aspect of our day-to-day operating practice, and monitoring of procedures is subject to regular inspection. Policy procedures are periodically reviewed and subject to review as part of our risk assessment processes.

Policy and Procedures

- Customers are regularly informed that they are responsible for ensuring that persons under 18 years of age are prohibited by law from playing category A, B and C gaming machines, and of the importance of efficient and effective monitoring of machines to prevent under-age gambling.
- Customers are informed that they must adhere to the conditions of their machine permits to the satisfaction of licensing authorities.
- All gaming machines, other than category 'D' machines, are inscribed with a notice prohibiting play by persons under the age of 18 years.
- Customers are informed that stakes must be returned to under-18s that have been identified gambling on machines and should not be allowed to retain any prize that may have been won.
- Members of staff are trained as part of their induction process in the understanding of, and the strict adherence to, this policy, and required to sign such policy document to this effect retaining a copy for their future reference. The original is retained on the employee's personnel file.
